

Keeping our school community safe

The school will do its best to:



Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection.



Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'community' show symptoms of COVID-19.



Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government.



Continue our clear and consistent approach to behaviour as set out in the Behaviour Policy.



Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs.



Communicate regularly between home and school through Twitter, e-mails and the school website so as to update parents/guardians.



Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19.

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:



I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this pandemic.




If my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe.



If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone.



My child must not bring any items into school with them or take items home from school unless instructed to do so.





My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene.



When dropping my child off and picking them up, I will stick to the 2 metre social distancing rules.



I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home by the school.



When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child.



I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carer and emergency contacts details.



I will not be allowed to enter the school and all visits outside school drop off/ pick up times will need to be pre-arranged.



I will discuss the content of this document with my child prior to him/her attending the school under the new guidance.



If my child shows symptoms of COVID19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately.

Our Pupil's Promise - I will:



Stick to the social distancing rules on school transport.



Arrive and leave school using only my allocated entrance.



Wash hands using soap/ hand sanitiser thoroughly on arrival to school and at other points throughout day, especially before eating and as directed by an adult.



Use hand sanitiser if hand washing not practical, as directed by adult.



Follow the modified layout and systems of movement around the school.



Follow the 2m distancing guidance around school



Tell an adult straight away if I feel unwell or have been coughing quite a lot.



I will not touch or hug other pupils.



Keep my mobile telephone out of sight and not hand it to another pupil so as to ensure good hygiene



Only use the resources, equipment or apparatus in the classroom or outside that an adult tells me is safe to use.



Not bring things into school from home, or take things home from school unless instructed to do so.



Not share equipment, drinks bottles, food, cutlery or plates and cups etc.



Follow instructions about staying within my allocated group in class, outside or anywhere else in school.



If I need to cough or sneeze use I will use a tissue and then put it in the bin or otherwise cough or sneeze into my elbow/upper arm if I don't have a tissue. I will then immediately wash my hands.



Only use the toilet when an adult tells you it is safe to do so and again adhere to social distancing rules.



Change my clothes once I have arrived home from school.
