## Arrangements for Receiving Summer 2020 Results

### A2 Yr.13 Results – August 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020:

- Appointment time to collect your results will need to be arranged in the usual way such as Parents Evenings, which is to book your appointment time through the 'Parents Evening' pack - <https://ysgolglanclwyd.schoolcloud.co.uk/>
- The appointment system will open on **Monday morning, August 10<sup>th</sup>** at 9.00am, there will be a 5-minute slot available to collect and receive the results by a member of staff.
- The time for receiving results will be from **09.00 – 10.00** on Thursday morning, **August 13<sup>th</sup>**. Please be punctual for the appointments.
- There are 4 members of staff available in each time slot – it doesn't matter which time slot is registered at a particular time.
- If you need further discussion about the results, UCAS applications, colleges etc there will be an opportunity for discussion following this session – information regarding these arrangements will be available on the day.
- Due to the restrictions and rules relating to Covid-19, there will be clear measures to follow in the building such as keeping social distance, cleanliness etc. Please urge your child not to embrace friends during this morning.

### AS Yr.12 Results – August 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020:

- Appointment time to collect your results will need to be arranged in the usual way such as Parents Evenings, which is to book your appointment time through the 'Parents Evening' pack – <https://ysgolglanclwyd.schoolcloud.co.uk/>
- The appointment system will open on Monday morning, **August 10<sup>th</sup>** at 9.00am, there will be a 5-minute slot available to collect and receive the results by a member of staff.
- The time for receiving results will be from **10.00 – 11.00** on Thursday morning, **August 13<sup>th</sup>**. Please be punctual for the appointments.
- There are 4 members of staff available in each time slot – it doesn't matter which time slot is registered at a particular time.
- If you need further discussion about the results, information regarding these arrangements will be available on the day.

- The time for receiving results will be from **9.00 – 11.00** on Thursday morning, **August 20<sup>th</sup>**. Please be punctual for the appointments.
- There are 6 members of staff available in each time slot – it doesn't matter which time slot is registered at a particular time.
- If you need further discussion about the results, returning to 6<sup>th</sup> form, colleges etc there will be an opportunity for discussion following this session - information regarding these arrangements will be available on the day.


