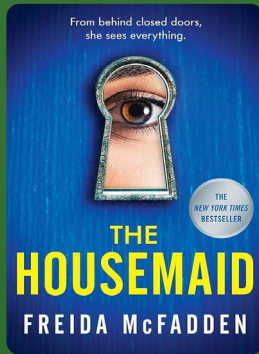
Tips for parents on how to encourage your child to read

- Connect reading to your teen's passion

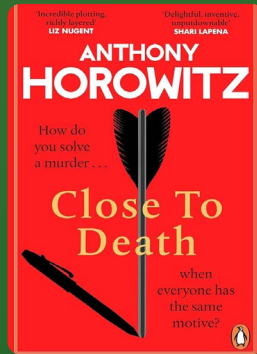

-  Defnyddiwch wahanol ffyrdd o adolygu: cardiau fflach, post-its ar yr oergell neu ar eich desg, mapiau meddwl.
-  Gwiriwch eich dysgu: darllenwch eich nodiadau → cau'r llyfr → profwch eich hun → gwirio'r atebion → ailadrodd.
-  Recordiwch eich hun yn darllen y gwaith. Ailwrando.
-  Ticiwch eich rhestr adolygu wrth i chi fynd ymlaen: Beth ydych chi'n ei wybod yn dda? Beth sydd angen mwy o waith?
-  Defnyddiwch y dull 25:5: 25 munud o adolygu → 5 munud o seibiant → ailafael.
-  Peidiwch ag adolygu'n rhy hwyr - mae cwsg yn bwysig iawn i'ch ymennydd.
-  Ar ôl sesiwn adolygu, gwobrwywch eich hun drwy fynd am dro neu wyllo ffilm.
-  Holwch eich athrawon os oes rhywbeth dydach chi ddim yn ei ddeall – mae hynny'n normal ac yn iawn!

Does dim modd torri corneli wrth adolygu! Rhaid buddsoddi amser a dal ati. Dim ond chi all wneud hyn. Wrth adolygu'n gyson, byddwch yn lleihau straen arholiadau ac yn codi'ch hyder.



Revision Tips

As we approach exam season here are some revision tips for you to share with your teenager

-  Put your phone away — ideally in another room so it can't distract you.
-  Find a good place to revise where you can stay organised and focused.
-  Make a revision timetable that helps you cover every topic and go back over things before the exams.
-  Use your classwork and Google Classroom to make a list of what you need to revise for each subject.
-  Try different revision methods: Flashcards, Post-its on your fridge or desk Mind maps
-  Check your learning: read your notes → close the book → test yourself → check answers → repeat.
-  Record yourself reading your notes and listen back to help things stick.
-  Tick things off as you revise. Notice: What you know well? What needs more practice?
-  Use the 25:5 method: 25 minutes of revision → 5-minute break → repeat.
-  Don't revise too late. Sleep helps your brain remember things.
-  Reward yourself after a session — go for a walk or watch something you enjoy.
-  Ask your teachers if you're stuck — that's what they're there for!

There is no quick fix for revision! You have to invest time and keep going — only you can do it. If you revise regularly, exams will feel less stressful and your confidence will grow.
