EXPERIENCE TALKS FOR THE SIXTH FORM

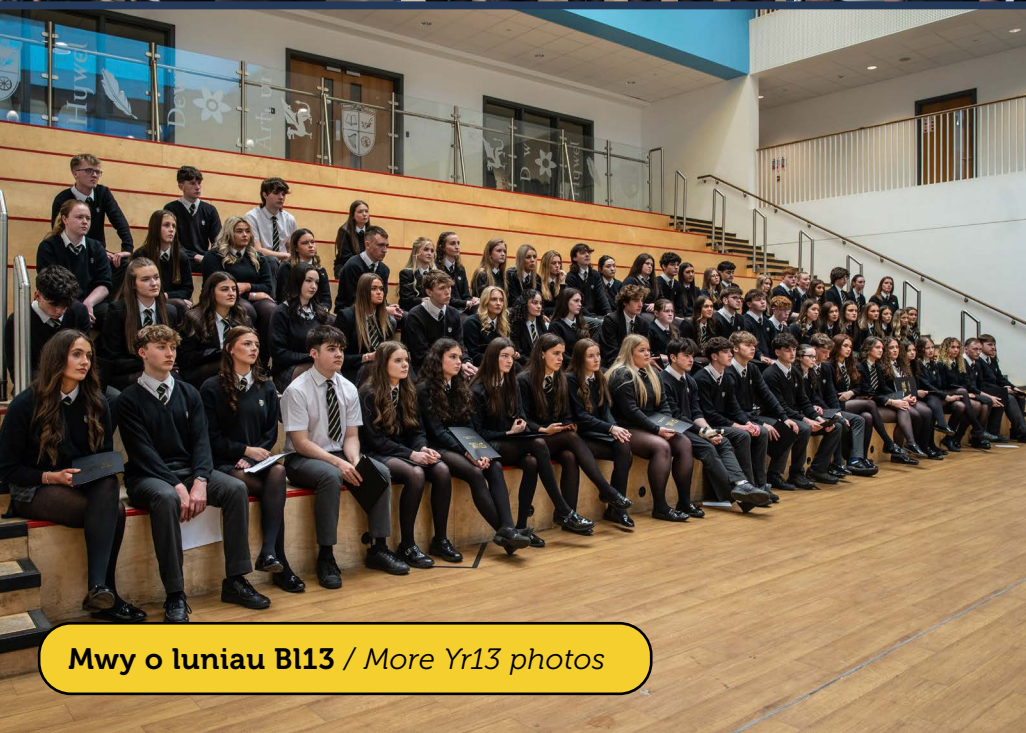

FAREWELL TO YEARS 11 AND 13

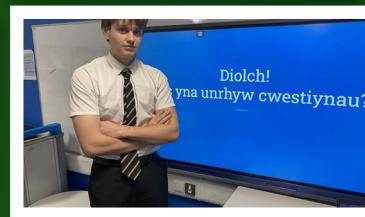

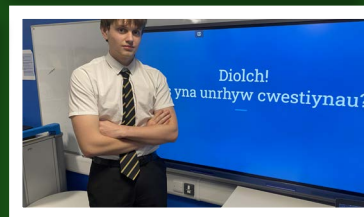

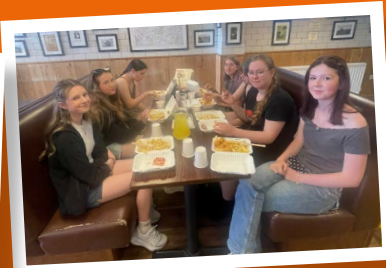
HWYL YR HAF A DYDDIAU TROSLWYDDO BL6

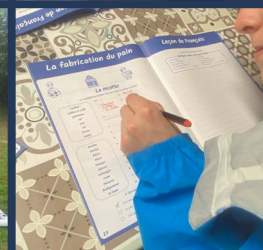
END-OF-TERM TRIPS

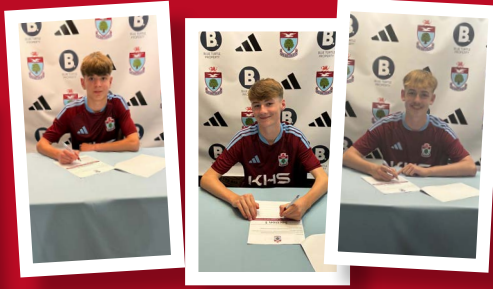
